

PROFILE: PETER FONDA



Peter Fonda has focused on acting since early childhood, and studied it at the University of Nebraska. While there, he was a part of a theatre troupe which previously featured another legend, Marlon Brando. Peter Fonda's next steps led him to Broadway and later to appearances on TV shows. He soon caught the eye of filmmakers and there were no more obstacles on his way to Hollywood. After several minor achievements, international success came thanks to Easy Rider. Fonda wrote the screenplay for the famous road movie, portrayed one of the leading roles, produced it, and collaborated on direction with Dennis Hopper. His screenplay earned him an Oscar nomination. And he got another one for his role in the drama Ulee's Gold. He also won a Golden Globe for this role, and his portrayal of a supporting character in The Passion of Ayn Rand earned him his second Golden Globe. Apart from countless film roles, he has appeared in documentary films, TV series and shows. During his career, he has written two screenplays, produced two films, directed three, and lent his voice to a character in the GTA: San Andreas computer game. Fonda's big comeback is marked by 3:10 to Yuma, a remake of a classical western, where he played a bounty hunter alongside Christian Bale and Russell Crowe. Peter Fonda's successful career is significantly influenced by

the fact that he belongs to a family of legendary actors. He is the son of one of the greatest stars of American cinema, Henry Fonda. His older sister, Jane Fonda, found fame in the 1960s as a film pop-culture icon thanks to her role in the iconic sci-fi *Barbarella*.
